



BROOD

BLOOD SYNDICATE

Harlem/Fort George. Gray military camo and aviator sunglasses. Expertise in Kung-fu.

GARGOYLES

MIDNIGHT BALLET

RED FANG

NIGHTSTALKERS

Midtown. Long hair, headbands, and sued leather vests. Wielding bowie knives.

HEMORRHAGES

Upper West Side. Ex-prison gang. Shaved heads. Tattoos. Wall-to-wall muscle. Pipes and chains.

COSSACKS

Gramercy/Stuyvesant. A biker gang with Slavic symbols on their leather jackets. Katana swords.

DISCIPLES

Greenwich Village. They wear long, hooded robes, speak softly and carry heavy, wooden staves.

WALL STREET SHARKS

Financial District. Grey, three-piece suits. Their leather briefcases conceal an array of deadly throwing blades.

VERMIN
